Registration: For convenience you may register two ways

1. Online at **IBSA.org**. (You can pay with a credit card or debit card)
2. You may also register by mail using the enclosed form. (make your check out to IBSA)

Preferably registration will be completed as soon as possible to help the church with meal planning and preparation. Registration at the door, if necessary, will also be acceptable, but we can not guarantee that you will receive a t-shirt.

Cost: We are charging \$5.00 per person for this event which includes the t-shirt, prizes and the supper snack. There will also be a store to purchase various items.

Schedule: Registration begins at 12:30 p.m. with the activities beginning at 1:00 p.m. and concluding at 6:00 p.m.

General: Awards as noted for events will be given in three age groups (under 10 years old, 10 - 13 years old, and all others).

Activities Include:

Missionary Guest Speaker: Hear the testimony of someone just back from being on mission explain what they did and how God blessed their effort.

Walk/Run for Missions:

See the downloadable Children's Mission Day Walk/Run for Missions form (IBSA.org) for more details. Awards will be given for the top three in money raised and fastest in each age group.

Speak Out:

See the Children's Mission Day Speak Out notes below for more details. Awards will be given for the top three speeches, testimonies, or demonstrations in the first two age groups.

Camp Craft:

Log sawing and chair pitching will be demonstrated. Participants will have an opportunity to try their hand at these activities. Awards will be given for the fastest three by time in each age group.

Races with awards for fastest three times in each age group for:

Racecars. 5-ounce max and size restricted. See the official website for racecars at www.royalracers.com – click on “craft kits” to order racecar kits - or order from Linda Darden (IBSA) at (217) 391-3137. All racers must be assembled from “kits.” Only racecars with the RA Racecar “RAZOR” wheels and axles will be allowed to race.

Sailboats: Participants can bring their own sailboats or purchase a slightly used one to race from the Store that day. Sailboat “kits” can be ordered from www.royalracers.com – click on “craft kits” - or order from Linda Darden (IBSA) at (217) 391-3137.

Line Gliders: Participants can bring their own line gliders or purchase a slightly used one to race from the that day. Line glider “kits” can be ordered from www.royalracers.com – click on “craft kits” - or from Linda Darden (IBSA) at (217) 391-3137.

Turtles: Participants can bring their own turtles or purchase a slightly used one to race from the Store that day. “Kits” for turtles can be ordered only from Linda Darden (IBSA) at (217) 391-3137.

Basketball Shoot: Weather permitting, a basketball shoot out will be conducted on the parking lot with awards for the most baskets made in six shots from the designated area. Awards will be given for most shots made in each age group.

Mission Store: Slightly used racecars, sailboats, line gliders, turtles, and prop cars, as well as new “kits” for each, will be available at the Mission Store. Various RA emblem items and Dollar Store type knickknacks will be available for purchase.

Children’s Mission Day Speak Out notes:

Participants will give a 2-5 minute speech, testimony, or demonstration centered on the virtues or suggestions below, or on a topic they select on their own. Speak Out will be judged on content, delivery, adherence to time limit, and their response to one question from the judge at the conclusion of their presentation.

- Living out a commitment, such as the RA Pledge, as their lifestyle.
- Individual and group participation.
