

# Kaye's Crate



IL WMU President Kaye Shipley had a lifelong commitment to missions and ministry.

In Kaye's memory, IL WMU is going to pack a crate of clothes and shoes to be shipped to Ghana, West Africa. This will be known as Kaye's Crate.

Here's how it will work. If your family or church would like to participate, contact Marsha Johnson **by May 1** at (217) 391-3138 or [marshajohnson@IBSA.org](mailto:marshajohnson@IBSA.org) with the number of boxes you plan to pack. It is very important we have an accurate count. All boxes are to be the same size – 20" x 14" x 12" available from [uline.com](http://uline.com). Mark Shipley will have a quantity of these boxes available at the WMU Annual Meeting (May 4-5, 2010) and we will also have some available at the Baptist Building in Springfield.

Packing instructions:

1. Before you begin packing, print a label from IBSA.org. You will use this label to keep a list of the items you pack in the box.
2. Pack each box as tightly as possible with **good** used clothing (no coats, wool, thermals) and shoes. A good test of tightness is to sit on the box. If it caves in, more items need to be added.
3. Attach the label on the 20" side of the box (top left corner).
4. Seal the box with clear packing tape.

We will need \$20 **per box** to cover costs to buy the 40 foot shipping container and get it to Africa. Checks can be made to IBSA and designated for Kaye's Crate. The shipping container will be on the IBSA Building parking lot (3085 Stevenson Drive) in Springfield for just one day in July. We will provide the exact date and details about getting the boxes and packing the crate at a later date.

We believe the ministry project will honor the lifelong missions legacy of our beloved WMU President.

Come join the fun as we pack Kaye's Crate.
