Keys to Biblical Accountability When Discipling Women

Biblical accountability is key in helping us to stay on track in our spiritual journeys and is an important ingredient in the discipleship of women. Leaders can incorporate the following key ingredients into their women's discipleship pathways to promote and nurture biblical accountability.

- 1. Commitment to Christ being Lord of our lives not just savior.
 - a. Spiritual Discipline accountability
 - b. Sin Accountability
- 2. A Spiritually Mature Leader
 - a. Mature may not be older. (Woman to Woman)
- 3. A vision for Disciple-making (Multiplication)
- 4. The role of the Holy Spirit
- 5. Prayer
- 6. The Bible—the source of all we say and do (Study God's word; active word; don't try to replace the role of the Holy Spirit)
- 7. Ground Rules (What to expect regarding accountability)
 - a. Boundaries
 - b. Confidentiality
 - c. Accountability (Biblical Accountability-the bible has is always the reference, not feelings, traditions, culture, or law)
- 8. Grace: the group is not the source of strength only. God; is our love of God increasing? (Revelation)
