Parks

- Lincoln Park
 - Home to the Lincoln Park Zoo, restaurants, botanical garden, shops, live music
- Oz Park
 - Features Dorothy's Playground, a community garden, tennis courts, ball fields, and basketball courts
- Humboldt Park
 - Center of Puerto Rican culture
- Grant Park
 - Iconic landmarks and attractions like the aquarium, natural history museum, planetarium, lakefront views, gardens
- Garfield Park Conservatory
 - 8 indoor display botanical gardens, one of the largest in the country
- Promontory Point
 - Scenic man-made peninsula sticking out into Lake Michigan, located within Hyde Park
