Commonly asked questions about Priority:

Q: Can I still register for Priority and invite my friends to attend?

A: Yes, we encourage you to register at IBSA.org/priority and to invite your friends. Priority is going forward as planned, just at a different location.

Q. Can I still register for the breakfast, dinner, and boxed lunch options?

A: Yes, we are still offering the breakfast, dinner, and boxed lunch options. You may register for them here on our webpage.

Q. Do I need to call the Wyndham City Centre in Springfield to cancel my hotel reservations?

A. No, this was done for you when the contract between the Wyndham and Priority was cancelled. You will not be charged by the Wyndham.

Q. Can I call and book a new room in a Decatur area hotel?

A. Absolutely! We have compiled a list on <u>www.ibsa.org/priority</u> of area hotels including their phone numbers and addresses to help make it easier for you.

Q. Will childcare still be available?

A. Yes, Illinois Baptist Disaster Relief childcare volunteers will be onsite to care for your little ones while you enjoy the conference. However, pre-registration for childcare is required which you can do when you <u>register</u> to attend Priority.

Q. Are simulcast options still available?

A. Definitely! Churches interested in simulcasting Priority can find out how <u>here</u>. We will even be live streaming some breakouts!

Q. Is the April 24 pre-conference still going to take place?

A. The <u>pre-conference</u> is a go, but it will be held in Springfield at the <u>IBSA Building</u>. The schedule and workshops remain the same, only the location has changed.

Q. Have the breakouts changed?

A. No, we are offering the same <u>breakouts</u> as before. The only change is in the location.

Q. Will there still be an exhibit hall, Lifeway store, and fairtrade booths?

A. We're going to have a robust exhibit hall that you won't want to miss, including a Lifeway store, fair-trade artisans, and a 360-photo booth to enjoy with your friends.
